Dear 6th Grade Families,

As part of our Western Hemisphere studies, Coronado 6th graders are invited to attend a field trip to the Denver Art Museum on Thursday, December 15th. At the museum, students will explore the art and culture of Mexico from Pre-Columbian times to the present. We will leave school between 8:45 and 9:00 and return around 1:30. We will eat lunch at the museum and students will need to bring a sack lunch. If your child needs a sack lunch to be provided from school, please mark the permission slip and we will alert the cafeteria.

There is a fee of \$5 for students to cover the cost of the bus. This fee can be paid online through student fees on Jeffco Connect, or you can attach money to the permission slip and return it to your child's teacher.* Parents are welcome to come as chaperones. There is a cost of \$8.00 for adults wishing to join in the fun. Parents can ride the bus with us or carpool separately. We ask that you be at school by 8:45 to get your group assignments and any further information about our day at the museum, and to arrange car pools for those who drive separately..
