How to Write a Great Informational Text!

Topic Paragraph: Hook the reader with a question, anecdote (story) or some background... Help them to know your main idea and how you will be sharing your ideas in the paragraphs to come.

Body Paragraph: Use this formula once or repeat for multiple body paragraphs

- A- Answer the question with a topic sentence for this paragraph. What is your reason for your answer.
- C- Cite an example or evidence that proves your reason.
- E- Explain how your example or evidence connect your example to your main idea/reason of this paragraph
- S- Summarize your ideas from this paragraph, particularly your main idea

Conclusion Paragraph: This is where you wrap up by summarizing all your main ideas and you leave your reader with food for thought.
